

Indiana University Bloomington 2014-15 Student I-BUCKS Meal Plan Contract Terms and Conditions

This contract is between you and the Division of Residential Programs & Services (RPS) on behalf of The Trustees of Indiana University. Your acceptance of the terms of this contract is indicated electronically below. If you are under 18 years of age, this contract will not be effective unless your parent or guardian agrees to its terms by submitting an electronic agreement.

Specific dining service costs are available online at www.rps.indiana.edu/costs.cfml. Charges for meal plans are based on a declining balance structure.

Eligibility

1. Any IUB student living in RPS residence halls or apartments, excluding students required by the terms of their RPS housing contract to participate in an I-BUCKS 60 plan, is eligible to purchase either an I-BUCKS 25 meal plan or any I-BUCKS 60 meal plan.
2. Any IUB student who is not an RPS resident or any person deemed eligible by the director of dining services is eligible to purchase either an I-BUCKS 25 meal plan or any I-BUCKS 60 meal plan.

Meal Plan Programs

3. The purchase price of all meal plans includes the payment of operational costs and I-BUCKS. I-BUCKS may be used at any RPS dining facility or the RPS online dining service.
4. I-BUCKS are not accepted at the Indiana Memorial Union (IMU), Cyber Café in the Herman B Wells Library, or off campus.
5. The following terms apply to the I-BUCKS meal plans offered by RPS:

Term	August 20, 2014 – May 8, 2015
Discount Applied at Purchase	25%
Payment	One-half of balance billed each semester. May pay online with bursar billing or credit card. Checks and cash accepted at RPS dining office.
Change Plans During Term	Yes, prior to August 1, 2014, you may change your fall semester meal plan to another plan for which you are eligible. Prior to December 1, 2014, you may change your spring semester meal plan to another plan for which you are eligible. These changes can be made online at http://go.iu.edu/AW or requested by e-mailing rpsdine@indiana.edu . Meal plans cannot be changed if a negative I-BUCKS balance results.
Buy Additional I-BUCKS During Contract Term	Yes, \$50 increments (includes a 10% operational costs charge, i.e. a \$50 payment less a \$5 operational costs charge equals 45 I-BUCKS)
Cancel Plan Before Expiration	No
Rollover of Unused I-BUCKS at end of Term	Yes, I-BUCKS remaining at the end of the 2014-15 academic year roll over and remain available for those enrolled at IUB to use through December 18, 2015 with a 25% discount off retail prices.

I-BUCKS 60

Term	August 20, 2014 – May 8, 2015
Discount Applied at Purchase	60%
Payment	One-half of balance billed each semester. May pay online with bursar billing or credit card. Checks and cash accepted at RPS dining office.
Change Plans During Term	Yes, prior to August 1, 2014, you may change your fall semester meal plan to another plan for which you are eligible. Prior to December 1, 2014, you may change your spring semester meal plan to another plan for which you are eligible. These changes can be made online at http://go.iu.edu/AW . Meal plans cannot be changed if a negative I-BUCKS balance results.
Purchase Additional I-BUCKS During Contract Term	Yes, in \$5 increments with a \$25 minimum purchase. No additional operational costs are assessed.
Cancel Plan Before Expiration	No
Rollover of Unused I-BUCKS at end of Term	Yes, I-BUCKS remaining at the end of the 2014-15 academic year roll over and remain available for students enrolled at IUB for use through December 18, 2015 with a 25% discount off retail prices.

Dates of Service

6. RPS dining services are available during academic sessions. RPS does not provide food service under this contract during Thanksgiving, semester, and spring breaks.

Payments, Late Fees, and Other Remedies

7. You agree to make your payments to the Office of the Bursar for your meal plan program contract rates according to the bursar's posted schedule. You agree that failure to make required payments does not relieve you of the obligations and duties of the contract. Past due balances on any part of your bursar account, including charges associated with this contract, are subject to the bursar's posted late fees.
8. Failure to pay your meal plan charges may result in the suspension of your dining privileges until the account is paid in full.
9. You agree to pay all reasonable costs and expenses, including attorney's fees, court filing fees, collection agency fees, etc., incurred by the university in enforcing this contract
10. The failure of IU to exercise its options under this contract does not constitute a waiver or relieve you from your remaining obligations and duties under this contract.

Lost and Stolen Cards

11. You are responsible for reporting a lost or stolen university card storing any I-BUCKS to Campus Card Services at 812-855-8711 or www.cacard.indiana.edu/cacard. You will be responsible for all purchases made with your I-BUCKS with the following exceptions for unauthorized purchases made with your card a follows:
 - a. up to 40 I-BUCKS if the card is suspended or reported lost within forty-eight (48) hours after you learn of the loss or theft of the card.
 - b. up to 200 I-BUCKS if the card is suspended or reported lost within 10 days.
 - c. all I-BUCKS if you suspend use of the card or report an unauthorized charge or the loss or theft of the card after 10 days.
